INTERPRETING SCRIPTURE TODAY

As the community of MB Churches in Canada, "we accept the Bible as the infallible Word of God and the authoritative guide for faith and practice" (Article 2, MB *Confession of Faith*). When reading the Bible, we bridge the gap between what we understand the text meant in its original context and what we discern the text means today.

We recognize the foundational authority of the Scriptures, the role of the Spirit, and the identity of the community as the primary interpretive context. We emphasize both the meaning of the text and the living out of the text. To this end, the interpretive model that we use incorporates the three core elements of **Bible**, **Spirit**, and **Community**, and the three core relationships of Authority, Understanding, and Discernment.

The Interpretive Method

In practice, interpreting Scripture involves four stages that interact with each other on multiple levels:

Posture — How do we approach the Bible?

- How do we adopt a posture that helps us be receptive to hear God speak through Scripture?
- How do our own situations and experiences provide a lens for reading the Bible?
- How do our culture and traditions, theological beliefs, and interpretive frameworks shape our perspectives and expectations regarding what the Bible says?

Interpret — What is the Bible's meaning?

- How does the genre of a biblical book guide our reading?
- How do we engage in a close reading (grammatical/historical exegesis) of a biblical text?
- How is a particular text understood within the larger canonical story?

Apply — How does the Bible relate to us?

- How does Jesus, the Living Word, bring clarity to the significance of the biblical text?
- How does the Spirit guide the community in its discernment and application of the Bible's meaning?
- How do we bridge the historical and cultural distance between ourselves and the world of the Bible, and consider voices emerging from social and natural sciences?

Live — How do we then live?

- How is the Spirit transforming our character, perspectives, and values into the image of Christ?
- How do we faithfully follow Jesus as his disciples and obey his commands?
- How do we put what God is saying through Scripture into practice in all of life?
